Our year 11 students are celebrating an outstanding set of results this year. With new, more challenging qualifications in English and Maths we are delighted that over a quarter of the grades are at the top 7/9 levels. Well done!

Again, a third of our students achieved the English Baccalaureate. This measure was harder to achieve this year, so this represents another step forward.

Overall, again, 73% of students achieved good passes in English and Maths and three other subjects.
