Chair's Report

Welcome everyone and thanks for attending the AGM.

A wam welcome to Andy Franks to the PTA – Andy is our teacher liaison on the PTA and if you don't know him, he teaches History and is on the senior leadership team.

As parents, grandparents, carers, and teachers of the children of the school, we are automatically members of the PTA. I'll briefly set out the role of the PTA.

The role of the PTA

The objective of the PTA, according to the constitution, shall be to advance the education of the pupils at the school. The Association may:

- Foster more extended relationships between the staff, parents, students, and others associated with the school.
- Engage in activities which support the school and advance the education of the pupils attending it.
- Provide and assist in the provision of such facilities or items for education at the school (not provided from statutory funds) as the general committee, in consultation with the school management body, shall from time to time determine.

The officers of the Association are Chair, Vice Chair, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer. The Officers are the Trustees under the Charities Act 1993.

Funds are spent in two ways:

- 1) Fund application process as agreed in 2020 whereby departments submit an application form stating details of the request, funds requested, which pupils will benefit and how. The committee meet termly to review all applications received by the deadline for that term and communicate the outcome to the requesting party.
- 2) Ad hoc requests outside of the above process e.g., urgent items required during COVID pandemic such as face coverings and laptops for students whilst learning from home.

How can parents/carers/teachers help?

- Attend events.
- Help organise events.
- Volunteer at events.
- Find out if your company offers fund matching for PTA events. We are signed up to Benevity which allows companies to support the chosen charities of their employees.
- Suggest fundraising ideas.

Every parent/carer is welcome to attend PTA meetings and if you are interested in any of the above, please contact the PTA. There is no obligation to take a role on the PTA Committee or organise events, but your ideas on fundraising events are always welcome.

Highlights of the past PTA year

This year it has been great to retun to in person events and this has really bolstered our finances, as per the Treasurers report. A massive thank you to everyone who has helped organise any of these events and supported them by buying tickets or goods – always so much appreciated.
