Results will be issued and ready to collect from school on results days in August as follows:

A-level	14/08/25	From 8:00am
GCSE / Levels 1 and 2 Technical Qualifications	21/08/25	From 8:30am

If you are not able to attend results day for any reason, we can arrange for your results to be emailed to your *school email address* on results day afternoon. Please ensure you have access to your school email before the end of term and update your password.

A friend or relative may collect results on your behalf. Please provide both the exams' office and your representative with a signed letter giving permission to collect the results. Your representative must bring photo ID.

Results can be posted to your residence if we are provided with a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
