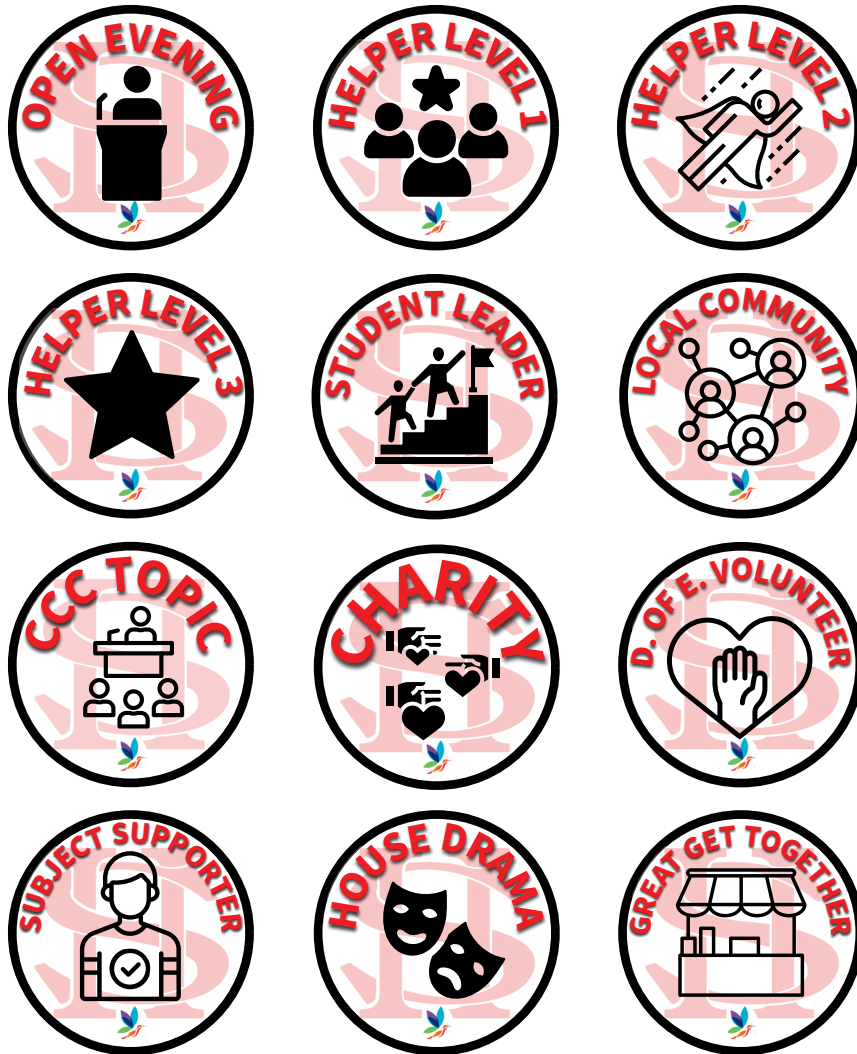


At Highdown we CARE

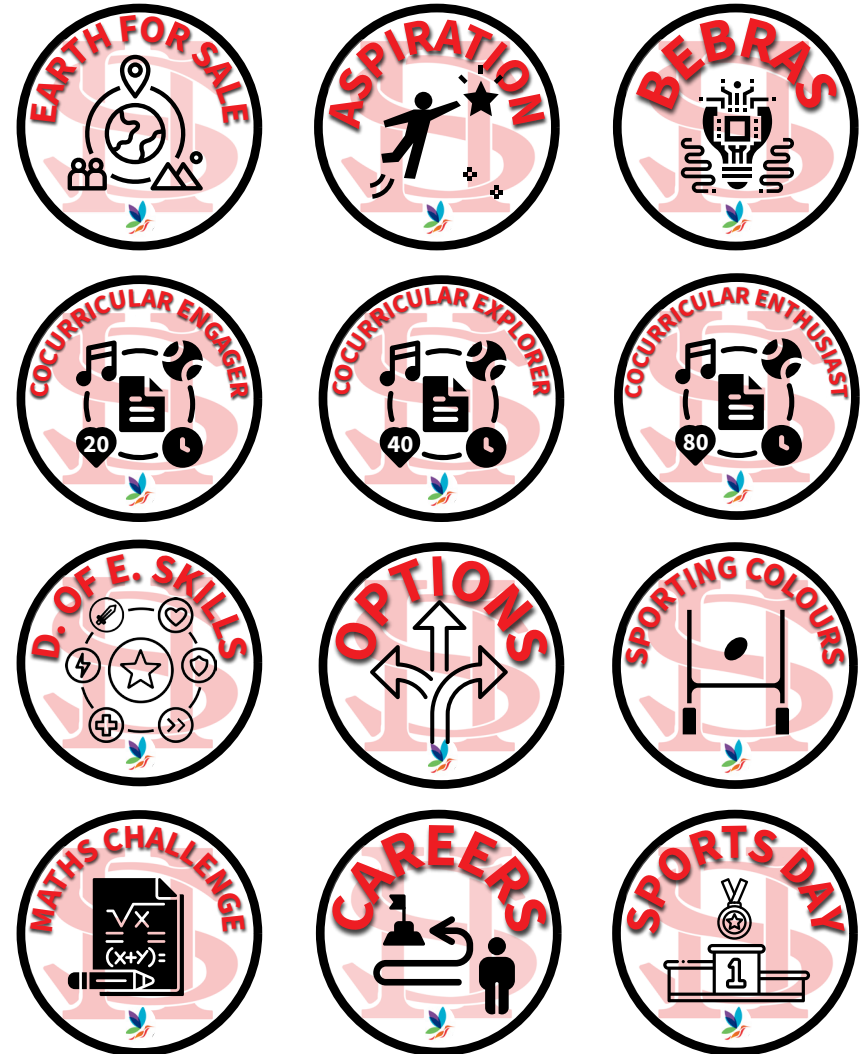
