

At Highdown we CARE

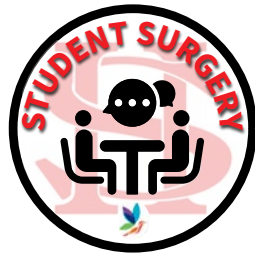
