Supporting with Revision

Revision is vital for all students but it can lead to a great deal of stress and anxiety. We've included some tips below for parents:

- Encourage your child to attend revision sessions to practise all skills. These will be tailored specifically to foundation or higher tier so make sure they attend the correct sessions.
- Key vocabulary learning for all topics learnt since the start of year ten is vital.
- Check understanding and accuracy of tenses.
- Ask your child if you can help them. Check their knowledge, chatting over dinner, use flash cards to quiz them etc...
- Ensure they have breaks, eat well and get a good work/life balance.
