The Year in Industry offers placement opportunities with 100's of top UK employers in all areas of engineering, science, IT, e-commerce, business, marketing, finance and logistics.

## Programme detail:

- **Eligibility:** Students must be eligible to work in the UK, interested in gaining real world work experience in the areas of STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) as well as general business experience in STEM organisations and must be highly motivated.
- **Duration:** One academic year – between 9 and 12 months.
- **Timings:** Placements typically start in July, August or September. Students are encouraged to apply as early as possible – the earlier the application the more opportunities available.

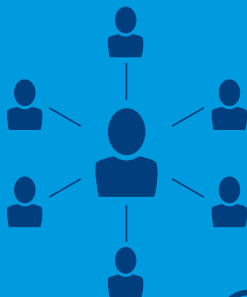

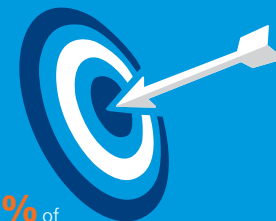
