

2018/19 - Year 7 Catch-Up Premium

The Year 7 Catch-Up premium provides additional funding to schools to accelerate the progress of Year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in English and Mathematics at the end of their Primary School Education.

Highdown School was allocated £7488 in 2017/18 and will receive **£7488 in 2018/19**.

This funding will contribute towards the cost of comprehensive programme of support in the 2016/17 academic year, including:

- Primary Trained Colleague to support learning in English and Maths in Year 7
- Learning Support Assistants offering extra intervention
- Reading Intervention

2017-18: Impact of Catch-up Premium

In September 2016 students who did not reach the national standard in English or maths at the end of KS2 were supported by:

- Primary Trained Colleagues to support learning in English and Maths in Year 7
- Learning Support Assistants offering extra intervention
- Reading Intervention
- Small group English support
- Small group maths support

We measured the impact of progress at set points throughout the year for the identified pupils. The impact was:
