



## Radio Book Report Competition

Those with a knowledge of music editing software are welcome to add music and sound effects to their podcast. Audacity is available on all computers in school, however the Ffmpeg library plugin that maybe required to make phone audio files compatible, isn't installed on every school computer. Help is available Tuesday lunchtime at radio club if needed to convert the file to a WAV or MP3.
