



# Exciting news Me2 Club is expanding!

The purpose of Me2 Club is to tackle the social isolation and loneliness caused by exclusion from mainstream activities. Working with our trained volunteers we transform the lives of children with additional needs and their families, ensuring 'Inclusion for All'.



We recruit and train volunteer 'buddies' who befriend each individual child. With help from a volunteer, children can join in with a wide range of fun activities including uniform groups, sports clubs and drama groups, giving chances to build independence and vital life and social skills. We support children to get involved in mainstream activity clubs on weekday evenings but do not provide volunteers for groups specifically for additional needs.

From the 11th November 2019 the registration list will be open to children living in the 5 Reading Borough wards of Katesgrove, Redlands, Park, Church and Whitley. Me2 Club will assess the response and are planning to start helping 5 children in the first instance and progressing to 15-20 by the end of March 2020. We encourage parents to start looking at activities prior to applying for a volunteer as this helps speed up the process.
