


COVID-SECURE ARRANGEMENTS



DELIVERING THE CURRICULUM

We will be delivering the full curriculum to all year groups. For most lessons in Years 7 to 9, students will be taught in their mentor group in the same classroom. Students will change rooms to access specialist equipment, e.g. IT, Science and PE. For Years 10-13, students will be taught in their usual teaching groups and may move classrooms more regularly. Some lessons will be reduced to 55 minutes to allow for socially distanced movement around the site. Students will sit in rows facing the front of the classroom.



BREAK AND LUNCHTIMES

We will be operating staggered break and lunchtimes through the day for all year groups. Students will queue, following the social distancing measures, on the KS3 side of the Gallery only if purchasing food. Students must only use their designated year group field/social space when not purchasing food at one of our outlets. Students must not mix with students from other year groups.



PROTECTIVE MEASURES AND HYGIENE

Hand sanitising stations will be available around the school site for students to use regularly. Wipes will be available in classrooms to enable surfaces/keyboards to be cleaned. There will be regular cleaning throughout the classrooms/buildings during the day. Face coverings must be worn in corridors and indoor communal areas, except in the classroom. If students have a PE lesson, they should wear their PE kit for the day.




ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Upon arrival, students must wait in their designated social space, i.e. their year group field. We will be staggering the end of each school day slightly to enable students to leave the site safely. Students must not congregate at the school gate and must go straight home. If using public transport, students must remember to wear a face covering.



EQUIPMENT

Students must bring their own stationery equipment as their teachers will not be able to lend them any equipment. Students may purchase items from our Finance office near Student Reception.



EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to embody our core values of Aspiration, Respect and Excellence. Expectations for behaviour in school and in the local community remain high. Students must respect social distancing, minimise contact and mixing with students from other year groups, not congregate in and around the school site and must follow the one-way system.



EVENTS
