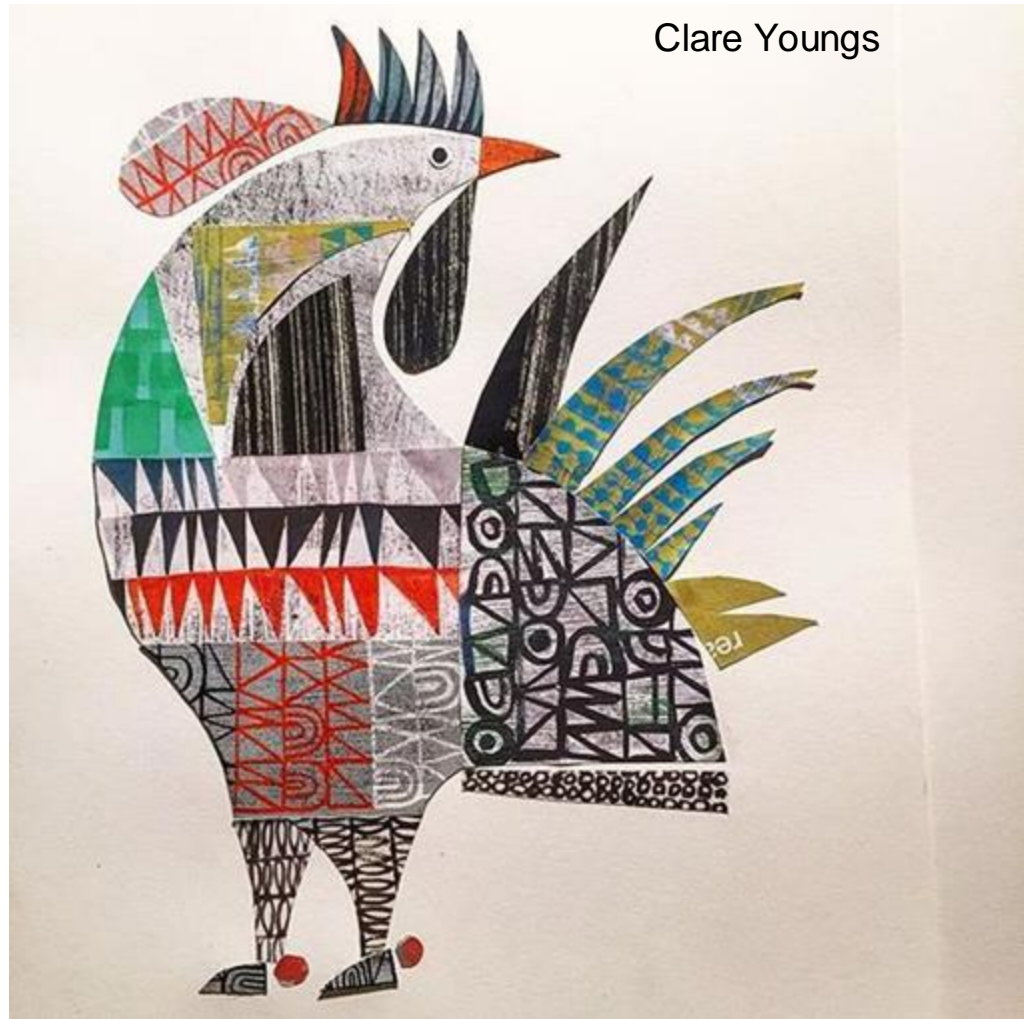


ANIMAL COLLAGE

This work will develop your use of media, colour, texture and pattern

Select an animal, bird or fish.

Find a picture on the internet.

Make a simple line drawing of the animal.





CREATE PATTERNS AND TEXTURES ON PAPER. YOU WILL USE THESE PAPERS TO COLLAGE ON TO YOUR ANIMAL DRAWING. TRY TO BE CREATIVE WITH YOUR USE OF MEDIA. THINK CAREFULLY ABOUT YOUR COLOUR PALETTE; YOU MAY WISH TO STICK TO A CERTAIN COLOUR.

Layering your patterns

Consider how you might build up your patterns by layering. You could work on top of your wash by adding marks/ patterns with gels pens, highlighters, coloured pencils and biros. You could even try printing on top.



Wax resist

If available you could use a candle, wax crayon or oil pastel to create your patterns, then paint a wash of watercolour paint, ink or watered down poster or acrylic paint, even tea or coffee over the top.



NOW YOU HAVE ALL OF YOUR PAPERS, CUT AND COLLAGE THEM ON TO YOUR ANIMAL DRAWING. THINK CAREFULLY ABOUT WHERE YOU PLACE THE DIFFERENT PATTERNS TO EMPHASIZE THE DETAILS OF THE ANIMALS FACE AND BODY, SUCH AS EYES, WINGS, ETC.
